What is a Nurse Honor Guard?

The nurse honor guard pays tribute to nurses after their death by providing the Nightingale tribute at their funeral or memorial service. This service is similar to a military tribute and officially releases the nurse from their nursing duties.

The nurse honor guard dresses in the traditional white uniform complete with cap and cape. The ceremony is brief; it takes about five minutes, and consists of reciting the Nightingale tribute and laying of a white rose on the casket or next to the urn, symbolizing the nurse's dedication to the profession. After the Nightingale tribute is recited, a triangle is rung after roll call for the nurse. The nurse's name is called three times and the triangle is rung after each call of the name. After the roll call, the words are spoken that the nurse is officially released from their nursing duties. A lit Nightingale lamp is carried up at the beginning of the ceremony and is then extinguished and presented to the family with personal condolences made.

What is a Tribute Ceremony?

A tribute ceremony includes:

- White rose presentation
- Nightingale tribute
- Final call to duty
- Nightingale candle presentation

Who is Eligible for a Tribute?

We will provide a nurse honor guard tribute to any active or retired registered, licensed practical, or advanced practice nurse whose funeral or memorial service is within our service area.

Nurse honor guard tributes are always free of charge and based on the availability of our volunteer members.
